ELECTION GUIDELINES:

- *The process of Election is Proportional Representation Single Transferable Vote (PRSTV).*
- *The Candidates receiving the highest number of votes are elected.*
- *In the event of a “tie” then a draw by “lot” (Note: Where the process by deciding by “lot” (Lottery) occurs, it is the Candidate first drawn out of the “hat” (traditional expression) that will be deemed the winner).*
- *All Elections shall be by secret ballot.*
- *The list of candidates and the online voting link will be sent to each PPN group’s primary contact.*

- *Each member group or organisation shall be entitling to one (1) vote and an individual (your group's primary contact) shall vote only on behalf of the group.*
- *PPN groups can only vote on their college/pillar seats.*
- *The election counting will be verified by PPN Staff and the Secretariat Election Sub-committee.*
- *Records of each Election must be maintained including details of each Count.*
- *All new PPN Reps must be ratified at a full council meeting of Cork County Council Elected Representatives.*
- *Any vacant seats will be put up again for election at the April Plenary. In the meantime, they will be temporarily filled by a PPN Secretariat member from the relevant college.*
